

Estate Agent and architect met at Potter House today to discuss the proposed plans for submission to the Borough Council. The preferred option is for a 3 bedroom house, then ground floor one bedroom apartment with 2 bedroom apartment above, demolish the skittle alley and replace with 2 ground floor 2 bedroom apartments and a 1st floor 2 bedroom apartment. Plans for this will be submitted for consideration by CBC and if approved final evaluation etc to be made in mid-November. Marketing will probably start in early March. The County Conference will be taking place in January next year. Nominations for delegates need to be forwarded to County HQ by 4 November. We also need to decide on our programme of committee meetings so that they can be recorded in the AGM Minutes. *It was agreed that they would continue to be held monthly next year except for January.* We have received an email from the Rifles County Office Gloucester informing us of their hopes to establish a Home for Veterans in Gloucestershire area. *Moyne Blake stated that she was happy to get involved.*

- b. **Treasurer** I did not have time today to run off the final figures for this year. The balance in the bank is just over £5000. The accounts are being forwarded for scrutiny on 14 October. Bill Kelly joined the RBL today and is willing to stand as Treasurer for the coming year.
- c. **Service Committee** We have handled ten cases this month including requests for carpeting, problems of arrears and debts, boiler replacement, re-housing, BT landline, Care Home fees.
